## CHECK LIST

### CAREER PATH FOR JET CONNECT<sup>1</sup>

In an effort to help all who dream of becoming a professional airline pilot, the Pilot Career Foundation (PCF) has entered into a training agreement with Delta Connection Academy (DCA) for the purpose of providing students with a clear path to the airlines.

#### GETTING STARTED

1. Join the Pilot Career Foundation.

Fill out the one page membership application which can be found either on line at [www.pilotcareer.org](http://www.pilotcareer.org), from your local PCF member flight school or call Lisa to enroll over the phone, (888) 356-0260.

Your tax deductible membership fee can be deducted from your student loan or charged to a credit card. Your annual membership fee is non-refundable and will be used to further the non-profit charter of the PCF.

2. Complete the  Application.

The one page Jet Connect application can be obtained from your PCF member flight school or by calling the PCF at (888) 356-0260. Mail the completed application along with a copy of your high school diploma (or college transcript) and 1<sup>st</sup> Class Medical Certificate to:

The required \$750 deposit (\$575 of which is refundable) can be deducted from your student loan or charged to a credit card.

This step needs to be completed as soon as possible. Advanced Training slots are scheduled by the PCF based on seniority.

### Financial Aid

The Pilot Career Foundation has made special provisions to assist you in reaching your goal of becoming a professional pilot by facilitating the Key Bank's Alternative Loan. Once approved, you may receive up to \$80,000 that will pay for your flight training at your local PCF member flight school and your advanced training at the Delta Connection Academy. Housing allowance is also available.

3. Apply for Financial Aid. (If needed)

To apply:

- a.) Go to [www.pilotcareer.org](http://www.pilotcareer.org) and click on individual members.
- b.) Click on "Financial Aid" at the top of the page.
- c.) Go to the Key Bank application.
- d.) Question #2 asks for the state in which your school is located. From the drop down list you must choose **Utah**.
- e.) Question #3 asks for the name of your school. From the drop down list you must choose the **Pilot Career Foundation**.
- f.) Next, you are asked to choose the school term. Choose **Semester**.
- g.) Next, you are asked to choose enrollment status. Choose **At least ½ time**.
- h.) Now you are asked to supply your graduation date. Regardless of when you expect to finish, enter **04/01/2008**.
- i.) The next question may not make sense, "Academic period?" Regardless of your start date, enter **Spring 2004** for Beginning, then for End, enter **Summer 2004**.
- j.) Finally, you are asked for a requested loan amount, choose **Up to \$80,000**.

### Disbursement of Student Loans

4. Follow Up With the Paperwork!

Once you have completed your Key Bank Alternative loan application, click on submit. In a minute or two you will receive the good news that you have been approved!

(If you're declined, don't give up. You will be given a phone number to call for a credit counselor and he/she will give you the reason for being declined. Often this is just a matter of a blemish on your credit that you didn't know about. If it is because you have little credit, you will need a co-signer.)

- a.) Now click on "Print Promissory Note".
- b.) Sign the Note and mail it immediately to Key Bank (address provided).
- c.) Make sure all of the paper work required on GETTING STARTED #1 and #2 has been completed and sent to the PCF.
- d.) The PCF will receive your funds about 48 hours after the receipt of:
  - Application for PCF Membership
  - Application for Jet Connect
  - Copy of Flight Physical (1<sup>st</sup> Class)
  - Copy of High School Diploma (Or College Transcript)
  - Confirmation of Key Bank's receipt of your signed Promissory Note

5. You are now ready to take your Flight Card, which has been "loaded" with your first disbursement, to your flight school and start on your career path to Jet Connect.

Remember: You can not use your Flight Card for uses other than flight training and associated expenses, cash advances, pre-paid aircraft rental or flight training (block time). Keep your card in your possessions at all time. All living expenses and tuition payments will be by check upon your request.
